



From Madrid to Palencia: Public Transfer Options

There are several ways to get from Madrid to Palencia.

Trains to Palencia depart from Madrid Chamartín station.

The fastest connection is the AVE and ALVIA high-speed trains, which will take you directly to Palencia in approximately 1:30 h.

On the website of the Spanish train company RENFE (<https://www.renfe.com/es/es>) you can get information about all train connections, check availability and buy tickets.

If you are in a rush, jump in a cab to Chamartín which will take you about 20 minutes and costs you about 30 euros (April 2023)

If you have time on your hands, the RENFE CERCANÍAS network (duration: 16 min.) from T4 (Madrid-Airport train station) is convenient and cheaper (about 6 euros (April 2023)). Tickets can be purchased at the ticket vending machines or at the RENFE CERCANÍAS counters in Terminal 4.

TRANSIT BUSES (green in color) run between Terminal 4 of the airport and the terminal building T1-T2-T3 every 10 minutes.

If you cannot find a suitable train connection to Palencia, you can also take the coach.

Coaches operated by the ALSA company depart for Palencia until late at night, some directly from Terminal 4 of the airport and others from Madrid-Moncloa station. You will find information, timetables and tickets on the ALSA website:

To get to Moncloa take a cab (see above) or the METRO (line nº 8 from Terminal 4; also stops at Terminal T1-T2-T3) to NUEVOS MINISTERIOS terminal station and from there continue with metro line nº 6 in the direction of LAGUNA to Moncloa station. The journey from T4 to Moncloa takes about 45 minutes. At the airport, follow the signs to METRO.
